

## **Lieutenant General Dimitrios Zafeiropoulos**

He was born in 1958, in Athens.

He was graduated at the Law School of the University of Thessaloniki, Greece, in 1980, and he is a holder of Master of Laws (LL.M) on Public International Law by the University of London (1993).

He has served at various posts of the Greek Ministry of National Defence, both judicial and administrative. His judicial posts were Assistant Prosecutor, Criminal Investigator, Judge, Head Prosecutor and Chief Judge, in three Military Courts of first instance (Athens Land Forces Military Court, Piraeus Navy Military Court and Athens Air Force Military Court), Judge and Vice Prosecutor in Athens Military Appellate Court. Further, he has served at various administrative posts as legal advisor, such as the Construction Department of the Greek Air Force General Staff, the Legal Office of the Greek National Defence General Staff and the International Law Section of the Greek National Defence General Staff.



Currently, he is the Head Prosecutor in Athens Military Appellate Court.

He is the author of a volume on International Humanitarian Law which was edited in April 1996 and has been widely distributed in the Greek Armed Forces.

He has taught Military Criminal Law and Public International Law in various military schools, at various levels.

He is the Senior Vice President of the International Society for Military Law and the Law of War and a member of the International Association of Prosecutors.
