

**EUGENE R. FIDELL**

EUGENE R. FIDELL is Senior Research Scholar in Law and Florence Rogatz Visiting Lecturer in Law at Yale Law School, where he teaches Military Justice, Guantánamo, Law of the Sea, Admiralty, Federal Indian Law, and Disasters. He has also taught Military Justice at Harvard Law School and the Washington College of Law, and is of counsel at the Washington, D.C. law firm Feldesman Tucker Leifer Fidell LLP. He is a graduate of Queens College and Harvard Law School, served as a judge advocate in the United States Coast Guard from 1969 to 1972, and graduated with honor from the Naval Justice School.



Mr. Fidell is president of the Committee for Military Justice of the International Society for Military Law and the Law of War and was named to the Defense Legal Policy Board by U.S. Secretary of Defense Leon Panetta in 2012. He served on the American Bar Association's Task Force on Treatment of Enemy Combatants and from 1991 to 2011 was president of the National Institute of Military Justice. He is a co-author of *Military Justice Cases and Materials* (LexisNexis 2d ed. 2012) and editor of *Military Court Rules of the United States* (LexisNexis 2012) (forthcoming).
